Only one person from each faculty can be the ALIS 2025 Representative.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND RIGHTS

The ALIS Ambassador is considered to have accepted the following responsibilities until May 19, 2025, from the moment they are elected by the Board of Directors:

- Maintain communication with the ALIS 2025 Board of Directors and be accessible.
- Keep everyone within the faculty informed about ALIS announcements.
- Act as a contact person between their faculty and ALIS when necessary.
- Attend the planned "Ambassador Meetings" twice.

Upon fulfilling these responsibilities, they are entitled to benefit from the following advantageous situations:

• If four people, excluding themselves, from their faculty attend ALIS, they will be exempt from the scientific program fee.

- If ten people, excluding themselves, from their faculty attend ALIS, they will be exempt from the scientific program, gala program, and accommodation fees.
